Instructions for Subcutaneous Injections

Needle length used for all subcutaneous injections is ½ inch to 7/8 inch (23-25 gauge)

A volume medication between 0.5 and 1.0 milliters or less is usually administered to an adult in the upper arm, abdomen, thigh, or lower back.

- 1. Wash Hands
- 2. Check Expiration of medication
- 3. Draw up medication and place correct needle size on syringe
- 4. Select injection site, grasp skin between thumb and first 2 fingers, should have 1-2 inches of skin
- 5. Clean area with alcohol
- 6. Inject needle at 45-90 degree angle to skin, and push medication slowly
